We are seeking a dynamic and committed family physician to provide services in a unique primary health care centred at the Red Coat Primary Health Care Clinic in Assiniboia, Saskatchewan. The successful physician will enjoy an excellent work/life balance in these progressive clinics that allow for collegial arrangement/cross coverage for time away. This part-time position would be approximately 110 days/annum.

The Community:

Known for its welcoming atmosphere and small town character, Assiniboia offers attractive residential areas and various recreational activities. Located in South Central Saskatchewan, Assiniboia is within two hours of most major centers and is approximately 105 km south of the city of Moose Jaw and 72 km north of the International Boundary. Red Coat Primary Health Care Clinic and Assiniboia Union Hospital

The Clinic serves clients within a catchment population of approximately 6,500. This position works with 4 other fellow physicians to provide emergency room on-call coverage for the community hospital. A comprehensive range of health services are provided in Assiniboia. The hospital has 16 acute-care beds with 24-hour emergency on-call services and full laboratory services. There is also a personal care home offering Level 1 and 2 care and two long term care facilities offering Level 3 and 4 care. The Primary Health Care team currently consists of physicians, nurse practitioners, and medical office assistants.
