We are seeking a dynamic and committed family physician to provide services at Crescent View Clinic, which operates 365 days a year. The centre is an extended hours clinic that offers medical care and treatment for urgent, non-life threatening health conditions via an interdisciplinary team including physicians, nurse practitioners and Healthy Living Consultant support. The successful candidate will be required to provide services weekdays, weekends and statutory holidays between the hours of 0930 and 2000 hours.
