Five Hills Approves Balanced 2016/2017 Operating and Capital Budget

The Five Hills Regional Health Authority (FHRHA) approved the 2016/2017 operating (\$160.4 million) and capital budgets at a special meeting held July 21, 2016. The budget remains largely status quo from a quantitative perspective, though it does contain increases related to collective bargaining increases, Out of Scope compensation increases and Saskatchewan Medical Association remuneration increase.

A number of changes are included in the operating budget to achieve the Region's share of the \$7.5 million in administrative savings including a \$377K reduction in administrative positions through vacancy management (one Vice President position, one Labor Relations position, and one Continuous Improvement position) and a decrease in the Senior Medical Officer position from full-time to part-time. These reductions will result in an increase of 7.0 FTE positions in Long Term Care.

The approved capital budget of \$4.8 million includes \$3.2 million for equipment, \$1.3 million for infrastructure and \$0.3 million for debt repayment.

Betty Collicott, FHRHA Chairperson, expressed thanks on behalf of the Board. "Thank you to our management team for the tremendous work to find savings and ensure we can continue to deliver high quality health care services."
