Can you be a First Responder?

Who can become a First Responder?

- Anyone with a valid CPR Level “C” HCP (within 1 year)
- A CPR Class is held prior to the First Responder Course
- Over 18 years of age
- Current Criminal Record Check (within 6 months of course date)

How long is the course?

The course is a 40-hour certificate program whose partnership involves Saskatchewan Health and the Canadian Red Cross, which is instructed over 2 weekends.

What do you need to do to maintain the First Responder certification?

All that is required is to maintain yearly educational requirements such as certain mandatory subjects and CPR C, all of the education is provided throughout the year.
