This modern, efficient office uses an electronic health record (Med Access) and provides initial comprehensive assessments, care and follow up to Moose Jaw area residents and Newcomers (government-assisted refugees). The Physician may be required to provide visiting services to nearby Central Butte which includes clinic duties as well as overseeing care of long-term care patients. Physicians have the opportunity for inpatient care for their patients. The successful physician will enjoy an excellent work/life balance in this progressive clinic that allows for cross coverage for time away. Night call is not required for this position, unless you will be practicing obstetrics.

Moose Jaw is the fourth largest city in the Province of Saskatchewan with a population of approximately 34,000. You will find a high standard of living at an affordable rate. There are many great leisure activities for you and your family. The beautiful Wakamow Valley offers endless opportunities for hiking, running and walking.
